Search	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Click on Advanced search and use the search field to the right of Title/abstract• Place each search item on its own line, put phrases in quotation marks ("climate change").• Use hyphens where possible (climate-change) and truncate with an asterisk * to search for multiple endings of a word (child* will search for child, but also children).• Phrases in quotation marks cannot be truncated, only the last word in a hyphenated record can be truncated (climate-change*).• Combine synonyms within the same search element with OR, and different search elements with AND• Use the Publication type filter function and select Systematic Review• Consider narrowing down to relevant publication years via the Publication year filter. <p>Search (P): child* OR adolescen* OR teen* AND Search (I): "climate change" OR climate-change* OR "global warming" AND Search (O): "mental health" OR depress* OR anxiety</p>
