## Question

What are the effects of preventive measures on **radicalization and violent extremism** among **children and young people**?

## Search element / PICO

**Problem (P):** radicalized/violent children and young people

## Search

- Click on Advanced search and use the search field: Title/abstract
- Place each search element on its own search line; enclose phrases in quotation marks ("hate speech") and truncate with \* for multiple endings (child\* will search for child and also children)
- Search for any synonyms/word variants for each search element
- Combine synonyms with OR within the same search item and different search items with AND
- Use the filter function and narrow down to Publication type: Systematic Review
- Consider narrowing down to relevant publication years via the Publication year filter

**Search (P):** child\* OR adolescen\* OR teen\* **AND**

**Search (P):** radicali\* OR "hate speech" OR "violent extremism"
