Search element / PICO

Population (P): Children

Intervention (I):
Lifestyle interventions

Outcome (O):
Fruit and vegetable intake

Search

- Enter search terms in the search field.
- Put phrases in quotes ("healthy lifestyle") and truncate with an asterisk \* to search for multiple endings of a word (child\* will search for child, but also children).
- Phrases in quotation marks cannot be truncated.
- Write OR between any synonyms, and put parentheses around them.
- Write AND between the parentheses.
- Use the filter function and consider narrowing down to relevant release years.

**Search (P) AND (I) AND (O):** (child\*) AND (educat\* OR curriculum OR school\*) AND (fruit\* OR vegetable\*)
